Miller joined the Kidoons team to help develop innovative content both onstage and online. Creating multimedia theatrical productions that thematically link to transmedia web series, Kidoons aims to educate, empower, enlighten and entertain young people.

Founding Artistic Director and Producer WYRD Productions 1995 – (pres.)

WYRD Productions is an award-winning company that creates and tours multidisciplinary theatre. It has become one of Canada's leading international exporters of culture and education, with past and present productions including:

- Twenty Thousand Leagues Under the Sea: A multi-actor, multimedia stage show, part of a larger transmedia initiative with Kidoons to engage youth with current water issues.
- BOOM: A solo multimedia show the most produced new play in Canada. It's part of a larger transmedia project that aims to bring history to the next generation of Canadians.
- *MacHomer*: A solo show that has played for 17 years in 165 cities to over 500,000 people. Its outreach campaign has opened a door to Shakespeare for countless students.
- o Bigger Than Jesus: A multimedia play co-created with Daniel Brooks, which Miller has performed in 4 languages all over the world. Rhombus Media is developing a film version.
- HARDSELL: A multimedia lecture/performance touring in English and French that has been developed into an information literacy campaign and a TV series with Foundry Films.

Co-creator and collaborator

Ex Machina is a multidisciplinary company created and curated by world-renowned director Robert Lepage. It brings together artists of various disciplines to create farreaching, border-crossing work that has won countless international awards.

- Drawing from his architecture training and his thesis on Lepage, Miller co-created and toured Lepage's Frank Lloyd Wright play La Geometrie des Miracles for over 3 years.
- Lepage, Miller and a group of multi-disciplinary artists collaborated with musician and creator Peter Gabriel on a revolutionary 'technological cabaret' called Zulu Time.
- Miller, Lepage and 8 other theatre creators from around the world created the international hit show *Lipsynch*, a 9-hour epic play that has played for 5 years in 10 countries.
