The Music, Culture and Politics of the **Baby Boom Generation**



The final show in the trilogy stirringly brings to life the years 1996-2020, and shifts our perspective to "Generation Y" (Millennials) and "Generation Z". Miller takes on over 100 voices, including his own daughter's, to reflect the aspirations and anxieties of young people today, and to bring the multi-generational story to a compelling close.
