

Official Ticket Raffle Contest Rules and General Conditions

These are the Official Rules for the Maxwell C. King Center for the Performing Arts, Inc. "WIN TWO TICKETS" prize drawing. The Maxwell C. King Center for the Performing Arts, Inc. (the "King Center") is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit corporation and is a Direct Support Organization of Eastern Florida State College (the "College") under Section 1004.70, Florida Statutes. As such, the King Center is organized and operated exclusively to receive, hold, invest, and expend funds for the benefit of the College and organization. Its primary purpose is to administer the day-to-day operations of the College's performing arts center. The Center's programs are supported primarily by ticket sales. By entering this drawing, all participants and winner(s) consent to the use of their names and likeness in publicity related to the drawing and its outcome without compensation and waives any and all claims against the Maxwell C. King Center for the Performing Arts, Inc. and Eastern Florida State College. College employees working for the King Center as well as their immediate family members (children, spouse), are not eligible to enter.

General Conditions: By entering, entrants accept and agree to the official rules and the decisions of the Maxwell C. King Center for the Performing Arts, Inc. and Eastern Florida State College.

1. Winner receives two (2) orchestra level performance tickets to every King Center-presented show and every show co-presented at the King Center beginning January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016. In cases where there are multiple performances for one named production, winner will receive two (2) tickets to one (1) performance of his or her choice.
2. Winner will not receive tickets to any show that is qualified as a hall rental. Any show or event in which an outside promoter rents the venue and in which the King Center does not receive ticket sales revenue (excluding fees), shall not be eligible as part of the raffle prize.
3. Suggested minimum donation of \$25 per raffle ticket. Checks and money orders should be made payable to the King Center and sent to King Center for the Performing Arts Ticket Raffle, 3865 N Wickham Road, Melbourne, FL 32935. All monies must clear for raffle ticket to be valid. All proceeds benefit the King Center for the Performing Arts programs.
4. Donations for raffle tickets will begin on Wednesday, July 1 at 12 p.m. and will continue until fifteen (15) minutes prior to the drawing at the King Center's scheduled performance of *A Christmas Carol* on DECEMBER 19, 2015 at 7 p.m. The winning ticket will be drawn by hand from a drum during intermission for *A Christmas Carol*. The King Center reserves the right to award prize to whom it determines to be the winner. All decisions are final. Drawing date is subject to change. In the event the drawing date is changed, entrants will be notified of the new date, time and place of the drawing at the address, phone number, or e-mail address indicated on the raffle ticket entry form.
5. Winner need not be present. Drawing is open to all raffle entrants. The winner will be notified by telephone, e-mail and/or U.S. mail at the information indicated on the raffle ticket entry form. Prize must be claimed within 30 days of drawing.
6. No purchase necessary. Participants must be 18 years of age or older at time of entry.
7. The donation for the raffle ticket is not tax deductible and donations to the Maxwell C. King Center for the Performing Arts, Inc for this raffle are non-refundable.
8. Raffle tickets may be purchased online at www.kingcenter.com, or by calling the King Center ticket office during regular ticket office hours of operation, or through King Center staff and volunteers.
9. Each raffle ticket entry must be registered with a bona fide King Center SABO ticket system sequence number to be valid.
10. Performance tickets are NOT EXCHANGABLE for other performances.
11. Performance tickets are NOT REFUNDABLE for cash.
12. Performance tickets are transferable.
13. Performance ticket prize may be revoked if prize winner is in violation of Florida Statute 817.36 regarding the resale of tickets.
14. Raffle winner will be required to register and establish a King Center ticket office SABO account or use an existing ticket office SABO account to receive the prize.
15. On or about the beginning of each month, the raffle winner will be presented with a list of shows for the next month to confirm the performances they wish to attend. The winner will have three (3) working days to select performances and notify the King Center account representative. If there are performances the winner is unable to attend and does not wish to receive tickets for a specific performance(s), those tickets will be immediately released back into the performance inventory. Once the performances for that month have been confirmed and the tickets are transferred to the winners account, no further activity will be permitted for that month.
16. Each performance on the selection roster will list: a.) day, date and time of performance, b.) fair market value of each ticket (inclusive of ticketing fees), c.) total fair market value for the two (2) tickets.
17. Raffle winner will be responsible for all taxes (Federal, State and Local) on the fair market value of tickets issued from the winner's King Center SABO ticketing account. In accordance with IRS Notice 1340, the winner must pay the organization 25% of the fair market value of the prize minus the amount of the wager which the King Center will remit to the IRS on behalf of the winner. An IRS Form W-2G will be issued at the end of the calendar year reporting the total fair market value for all tickets issued during the year. The estimated total fair market value for this prize is \$7,500. The total value may change depending on the number of performances the winner attends and the fair market value of each performance ticket issued.
