
PARTICIPATION INSTRUCTIONS & RULES

AUDITIONS: SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 16, 2017 – BY APPOINTMENT

AUDITIONS INSTRUCTIONS

1. ALL SOLO AND ENSEMBLE ACTS ARE WELCOME! Singers, musicians, actors, dancers, comics, poets, jugglers, puppeteers, impressionists, magicians, quick change artists...whatever other performing talent you have.
2. Eligibility: 1st through 12th grade student performers of all kinds.
3. All acts are required to audition and must audition with the exact piece to be performed if selected, with the same performers, costumes, material, format and length.
4. Performers should wear to the audition what they intend to wear for the actual performance.
5. Selected acts for the annual variety revue on October 21st will be notified via email within one week of auditioning. Acts will be chosen to create a variety of entertainment. Criteria will be based on entertainment value, showmanship and ability.
6. There will be a required orientation/dress rehearsal for all selected acts at The Lyric Theatre on October 21st with time to be determined prior to the event. Performers should bring at least one alternate clothing option.
7. Acts are limited to 5 minutes.
8. Acts must be "G" rated – see Official Rules for further details.
9. Anyone performing with a track, must furnish a recording on an mp3 player (preferred) or CD.
10. All singers must perform in one of the following ways:
 - A Cappella
 - With a recorded track that does not have lead vocals
 - Live accompaniment (provided by singer)
11. A piano will be provided by The Lyric Theatre, if needed. All other instruments or equipment used must be carried on and off the stage with the performers within the 5 minute allocated time.
12. No special flooring may be required or used in the show.
13. No scenery. Only hand props can be used and must be easily carried on and off by performer on entrance and exit.
14. Basic stage lighting will be provided by The Lyric Theatre.
15. All applicants must fill out a registration form and also a signed parental consent/release form if under 18 years of age. Forms are available on LyricTheatre.com/youth-arts-celebration. Completed forms should be emailed to Karin@LyricTheatre.com.
16. Audition times will be strictly adhered to. In order not to miss your turn, be sure to arrive 15 minutes before your appointment time.

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OFFICIAL RULES


In order to participate in The Lyric League Youth Arts, each performer must adhere to the following terms from the time of application to the conclusion of the show:

1. All participants must comply with all audition instructions.
2. The Lyric Theatre and The Lyric League will not be held accountable for any broken equipment, injuries, or any other negative occurrences outside of our control.
3. Any participant who appears to be under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or other controlled substances will result in disqualification from participating in the Youth Arts Celebration. In addition, the person in question will be asked to leave the premises for the duration of the event. The decision will be made by The Lyric League and will be final.
4. Keep it clean! ANY use of inappropriate or indecent language, gestures, material or costumes at any time will disqualify your act from participating in the Youth Arts Celebration. This includes, but is not limited to, profanity, explicit sexuality, racism, and any threatening, abusive, defamatory, libelous language.
5. Creative materials should not include brand name, trademarks, trade names, logos or the intellectual property of any third parties.
6. Release: Participation in the Youth Arts Celebration constitutes each entrant's consent to the use of the entrant's name, information, and photograph for promotional reasons and acts to release, indemnify, defend and hold harmless The Lyric Theatre from any claim or liability of whatever kind or nature. Parents must sign consent/release form for any participant under the age of 18.
7. Agreement to rules: By participating in the Youth Arts Celebration, all entrants unconditionally agree to accept the terms of participation. The Lyric Theatre reserves the right at any time, in its sole discretion, to disqualify a participant it believes is not in compliance with the Official Rules or who has made a false or misleading statement on the Registration Form.


