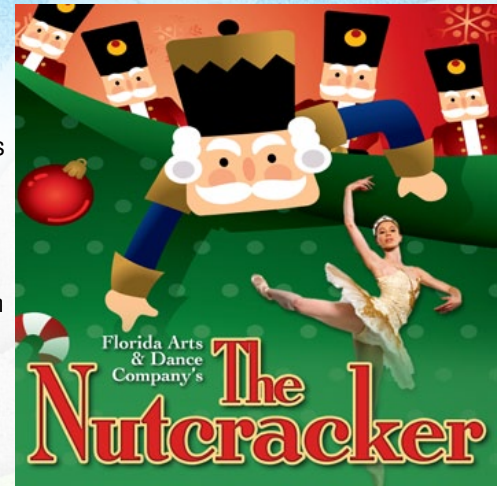


## Inspiring Young Minds through the ARTS

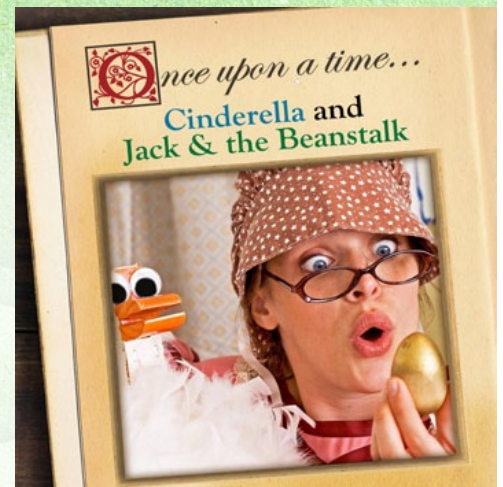
