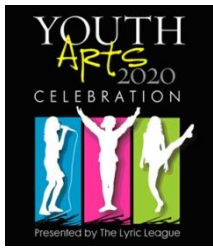

PARTICIPATION INSTRUCTIONS & RULES

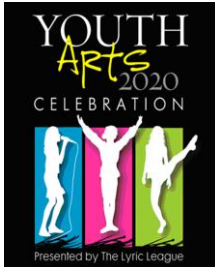
AUDITIONS: Sunday, March 8, 2020 from 1pm-4pm and

Wednesday, March 11, 2020 from 3pm-7pm

PERFORMANCE: Saturday, April 4, 2020 at 7pm

AUDITIONS: BY APPOINTMENT ONLY- Contact Sue Nauss (772)220-1942 ext 205 / Sue@LyricTheatre.com to schedule time. **ALL SIGNED PAPERWORK MUST BE SUBMITTED BEFORE SCHEDULING AUDITION TIME.**

1. **AUDITION INSTRUCTIONS** ALL SOLO AND ENSEMBLE ACTS ARE WELCOME! Singers, musicians, actors, dancers, comics, poets, jugglers, puppeteers, impressionists, magicians...whatever other performing talent you have.
2. Eligibility: 1st through 12th grade student performers of all kinds.
3. All acts are required to audition and must audition with the exact piece to be performed. If selected, act must be the same performers, costumes, material, format and length.
4. Performers must wear to the audition what they intend to wear for the actual performance.
5. Selected acts for the Celebration will be notified via email. Acts will be chosen to create a variety of entertainment. Criteria will be based on entertainment value, showmanship and ability.
6. There will be a **mandatory** orientation/dress rehearsal for all selected acts at The Lyric Theatre on April 4, 2020 with time to be determined prior to the event.
7. Acts are limited to 5 minutes.
8. Acts must be "G" rated. Keep it clean! ANY use of inappropriate or indecent language, gestures, material or costumes at any time will disqualify your act from participating in the Youth Arts Celebration. This includes, but is not limited to, profanity, explicit sexuality, racism, and any threatening, abusive, defamatory, libelous language.
9. Anyone performing with a track, **must** furnish a recording on a CD, flash drive or emailed and **must** be submitted 2 days prior to audition.
10. All singers must perform in one of the following ways:
 - A Cappella
 - With a recorded track that does not have lead vocals
 - Live accompaniment (provided by singer)
11. A piano will be provided by The Lyric Theatre, if needed. All other instruments or equipment used must be carried on and off the stage by the performers within the 5 minute allocated time.
12. No special flooring may be required or used in the show.
13. No scenery. Only hand props can be used and must be easily carried on and off by performer on entrance and exit.
14. Basic stage lighting will be provided by The Lyric Theatre.
15. All applicants must fill out a Registration Form and a signed Parental Consent/Release Form if under 18 years of age. Forms are available on LyricTheatre.com/Youth-Arts-Celebration. Completed forms should be emailed to Sue@LyricTheatre.com.
16. Audition times will be strictly adhered to, be sure to arrive 15 minutes before your appointment time.
17. The Lyric Theatre and The Lyric League will not be held accountable for any broken equipment, injuries, or any other negative occurrences outside of our control.
18. Any participant who appears to be under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or other controlled substances will result in disqualification from participating in the Youth Arts Celebration. In addition, the person in question will be asked to leave the premises for the duration of the event. The decision will be made by The Lyric League and will be final.
19. Creative materials should not include brand name, trademarks, trade names, logos or the intellectual property of any third parties.
20. Agreement to rules: By participating in the Youth Arts Celebration, all entrants unconditionally agree to accept the terms of participation. The Lyric Theatre reserves the right at any time, in its sole discretion, to disqualify a participant it believes is not in compliance with the Official Rules or who has made a false or misleading statement on the Registration Form.

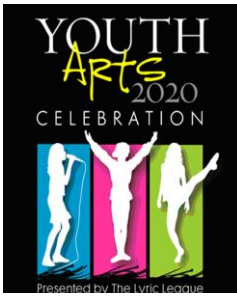
