

We had 30 live performances of an incredible cross-section of genres: a plethora of Rock, Swamp, Chicago, and Texas-style Blues bands, Jazz artists, County, Rock, and Folk singer/songwriters, Classic Rock bands, a Country music star, a Standup

Comedian, and family fun shows.

We had 108 AWESOME! Summer campers having fun and working to create two different phenomenal Sharings, showing off their performing arts skills through acting, dancing and singing. It's really powerful watching the campers make memories here at The Lyric. I hope that one day, they will be future stewards of art and culture and, selfishly, future patrons, employees, board members, or volunteers of The Lyric.

My favorite part of summertime is taking the campers on a tour of the 98-year-old Lyric. I get to share the history, teach them about theater operations and architecture (the ones they like best are the Proscenium and Vomitorium), play find the seat learning a typical theater seat numbering system, explore every inch from the box office to the basement (the dressing rooms before the backstage expansion), and close with working as a team to make the sound of a rainstorm.

Amongst all of that activity, there was the job of planning this upcoming Season, and it's a helluva of one so far, with even more shows coming! It's the largest number of shows that have ever been booked by this time of the year, and there's quite a diverse array of entertainment choices. You're sure to find something that appeals to you, and I hope you'll look for a show outside your wheelhouse and try something new.

A CASE OF SUSPENSION

Spring of 1913

Construction for The "first" Lyric began on Osceola Avenue near Belle Flora and opened for its first performance a year later.

The "first" Lyric was abandoned and moved to a little wooden structure on Osceola Avenue.





purchased the

Newly equipped with a RCA Photophone, Danger Lights was screened as the first "talkie."

The Lyric opened with the feature picture Skinner's Dress Suit. Cost of construction was \$100,000 and was the largest building in Martin County.



The Hancocks fell on hard times during the Great Depression and sold The Lyric to the bank.

1936-1978

The Lyric was rented out to community groups and was used to present traveling vaudeville shows, news weeklies, movies and eventually, a Performing Arts Auditorium

The Lyric was purchased by the New Life in Christ Church and used for weekly worship



historic theatre.

The Lyric was put up for sale. Seen as an anchor and much needed entertainment center, Roy Laycock entered into a contract to purchase the building. Believing the community should own The Lyric, Roy gathered a group of people with fundraising and operational backgrounds to ignite and support his vision.

Friends of the Lyric Friends of the Lyric became a 501(c)(3) organization.

1991-1995

With grant funding from the State of Florida, National Endowment for the Arts and local community funding and support, The Lyric underwent needed stabilization and repair: new roof and air-conditioning systems, ADA Compliance alterations, Box Office construction, marquee improvements and remodeling of the lobby, restrooms and dressing room.

The Lvric Theatre was listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

New Orchestra seatina was installed and administrative offices constructed

Vacant lot to the north of The Lyric was purchased for a future expansion.

The balcony of the theater was remodeled for the installation of new balcony seating, an elevator was installed and refurbishment of the lobby and restrooms

The Lyric expansion was completed, enlarging the stage 14 feet and adding a backstage equipped with a restroom and office/ storage areas.



A Capital Campaign resulted in substantial renovations to the lobby and box office, new exterior and interior entrances, new orchestra seating, new sound system and architectural elements added to the walls and columns.



2015-16

The Lyric's proscenium was ornamented in an Art Nouveau style. The elegant design, artistry



and craftsmanship of the trompe l'oeil art technique were added throughout The Lyric including the balcony parabet doorway transoms and interior theatre

With amazing community support for the Next Act Capital Campaign, The Lyric underwent critical structural and building renovations. Substantial structural column and beam replacement/repairs, new roof, new air conditioning units with state-of-the-art air purification systems, new signage to replicate the historic "blade" sign of The Lyric's past and restoration of the marquees.


