Summertime is when we roll out our upcoming shows and performances. While we have a range of artists and genres represented in this first round, I am not done booking. I am just getting started. We will have many more shows, performances, and events coming at you. So, stay connected with us.

**Lights. Camp. Action. AWESOME Summer Camp is in full swing.**  
This summer, our camp themes are “I Don’t Want to Grow Up: Learning to Accept Life’s Changes” and “It’s All Greek to Me: Exploring Greek Mythology.” Each theme is created to help our campers develop their own unique character on and off the stage.

Let’s face it, change is inevitable, and even for adults (some of us overgrown kids), it is hard to embrace change. Our campers are exploring what it means to face new challenges, celebrating personal growth, and learning that change can be exciting. Then they will embark on a quest to learn about the fascinating tales of Greek mythology – stories of bravery, wisdom, and teamwork. Campers will be encouraged to unleash their inner hero and be empowered to know that anything is possible.

I get the pleasure of spending time with these campers. Some start the first week timid, quiet, and shy. But by the end of the 3-week session, I can only say they are all characters! My favorite question to ask anyone, especially young people, on a tour or visiting The Lyric is, “Have you ever seen a live performance?” The reply I hear most is, “Yes, on a field trip with my school.” And it makes my heart and soul smile. The Discovery Series has been the foundation of our Arts & Education programming. For over 20 years, we have provided educational shows for our area schools focusing on academic subjects, with study guides supporting curricular requirements.

While contemplating our upcoming Centennial and The Lyric’s future, I realized that we have not provided this experience to our campers or area non-profits that serve our youth during the summer. Well, now we are - the Discovery Series will now be offered year-round, and it is free for our non-profits! My dream is that any young person growing up in the Treasure Coast will have a memory of the magical experience of a live performance.

I am sure I am preaching to a choir. We’ve all heard about the benefits of young people being exposed to or involved in the performing arts. Right? Do you remember your first live performance? Or when live entertainment moved your soul, shifted your balance, altered your perspective of life, culture, understanding...? I do, and it shaped me into the human I am today.

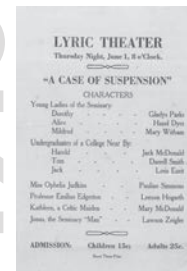


# HISTORICALYRIC

## A Brief History

Weaving together the history of The Lyric Theatre over the past 99 years is a story of community, commitment and connection. A community who joined together to support and save this historic treasure is our story. The thriving Lyric Theatre we now know is a testament to you, our Community.

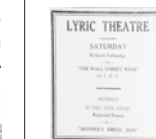
1913



**Spring of 1913**  
 Construction for The "first" Lyric began on Osceola Avenue near Belle Flora and opened for its first performance a year later.

**1917**  
 The "first" Lyric was abandoned and moved to a little wooden structure on Osceola Avenue.

**June 1925**  
 Judge JC Hancock began construction of the new Lyric Theatre.



**1930**  
 Newly equipped with a RCA Photophone, *Danger Lights* was screened as the first "talkie."

**1926**  
 The Lyric opened with the feature picture *Skinner's Dress Suit*. Cost of construction was \$100,000 and was the largest building in Martin County.



**1936**  
 The Hancocks fell on hard times during the Great Depression and sold The Lyric to the bank.

**1936-1978**  
 The Lyric was rented out to community groups and was used to present traveling vaudeville shows, news weeklies, movies and eventually, a Performing Arts Auditorium.

**1978**  
 The Lyric was purchased by the New Life in Christ Church and used for weekly worship services.



**1988**  
 Friends of the Lyric purchased the historic theatre.

**1987**  
 The Lyric was put up for sale. Seen as an anchor and much needed entertainment center, Roy Laycock entered into a contract to purchase the building. Believing the community should own The Lyric, Roy gathered a group of people with fundraising and operational backgrounds to ignite and support his vision.

**1989**  
 Friends of the Lyric became a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization.

**1991-1995**  
 With grant funding from the State of Florida, National Endowment for the Arts and local community funding and support, The Lyric underwent needed stabilization and repair: new roof and air-conditioning systems, ADA Compliance alterations, Box Office construction, marquee improvements and remodeling of the lobby, restrooms and dressing room.

**1993**  
 The Lyric Theatre was listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

**1996**  
 New Orchestra seating was installed and administrative offices constructed.



**1999**  
 Vacant lot to the north of The Lyric was purchased for a future expansion.

**2001**  
 The balcony of the theater was remodeled for the installation of new balcony seating, an elevator was installed and refurbishment of the lobby and restrooms.

**2005**  
 The Lyric expansion was completed, enlarging the stage 14 feet and adding a backstage equipped with a restroom and office/storage areas.



**2014**  
 A Capital Campaign resulted in substantial renovations to the lobby and box office, new exterior and interior entrances, new orchestra seating, new sound system and architectural elements added to the walls and columns.



**2015-16**  
 The Lyric's proscenium was ornamented in an Art Nouveau style. The elegant design, artistry and craftsmanship of the trompe l'oeil art technique were added throughout The Lyric including the balcony parapet, doorway transoms and interior theatre walls.



**2021**  
 With amazing community support for the Next Act Capital Campaign, The Lyric underwent critical structural and building renovations. Substantial structural column and beam replacement/repairs, new roof, new air conditioning units with state-of-the-art air purification systems and restoration of the marquees.

**March 2020**  
 The Lyric was shuttered by the COVID-19 Pandemic.



**October 1, 2021** The Lyric reopened.

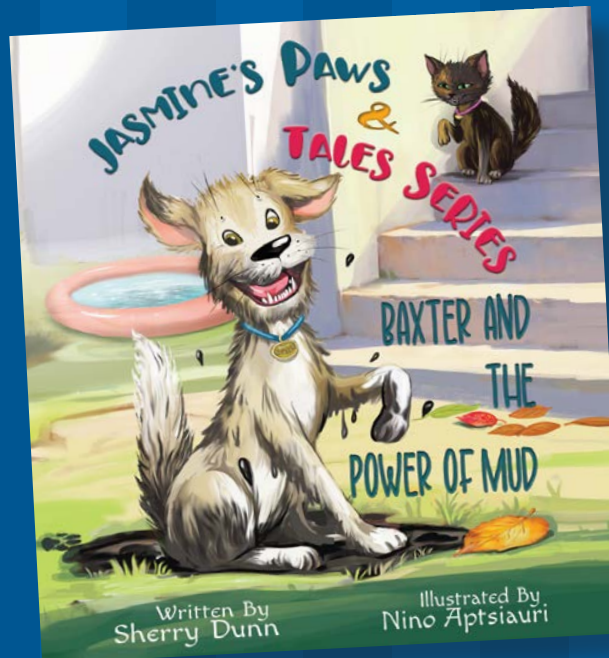
